She is also the leading analyst in an unprecedented survey of over one billion Muslims worldwide, the findings of which are discussed in *Inside Islam*. Mogahed is co-author of the book *Who Speaks for Islam?: What a Billion Muslims Really Think*. In April of 2009 Mogahed was also appointed by President Obama to serve on the Advisory Council on Faith-Based and Neighborhood Partnerships.

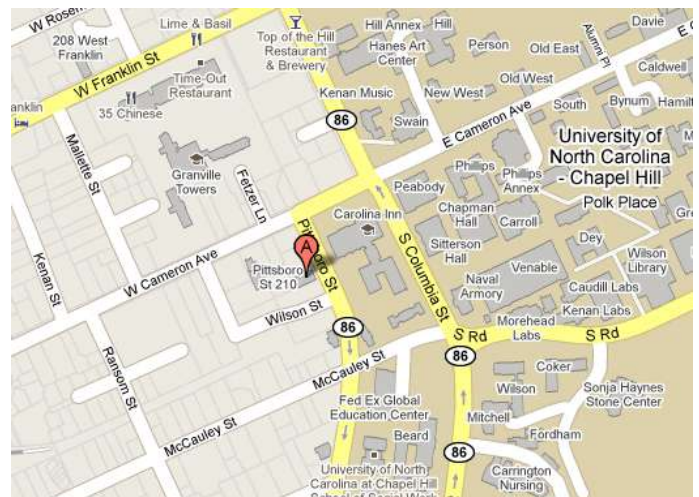
